

Accessible Food Provision

About

If you are finding it difficult to feed yourself or your family, you may qualify to receive a food parcel from a food bank, or to attend a community pantry to purchase affordable food. This information guide lists all the accessible food provision available across Barnsley.

Bettalives Priory Centre	Good Food Pantry. Open on Fridays from 10.30am to 12.30pm. Located at Priory Campus, Pontefract Road, S71 5PN.
BCDP Drop in	Operate a Barnsley collection service of hot drinks and a snap bag. Open on Mondays to Fridays and Sundays from 7pm to 8pm. Located at St. Marys Church, Church Street, S70 2AH.
Salvation Army	Drop in: open on Fridays from 10am to 12pm. Located at Community Centre, Straight Lane, Goldthorpe, S63 9DW.
Cudworth Foodbank	For residents local to Cudworth – Grimethorpe, Brierley, Shafton, Lundwood and Cudworth. Referrals from schools, churches, social workers and doctors. Open on Fridays from 2pm to 3.30pm. Located at Bow Street Council Offices.
Education, Learning Support Hub - Good Food Pantry	Serving Barnsley's migrant community. Open on Wednesdays from 1pm to 3pm. Located at 8-10 Market Street, S70 1SL.



Barnsley Foodbank Partnership - Trussel Trust	Referrals are through an agency: DIAL, Housing Welfare Team, Humankind, Family Support, health visitors, schools, Berneslai Homes etc. There are 13 locations across Barnsley. Located at Unit 14, Aldham Industrial Estate, Mitchells Way, Wombwell, S73 8HA
Royston Friends Association	Good Food Pantry. Open to all - you simply pay a small fee each week which allows you access to the pantry and its produce. Open on Fridays from 10am to 11.30am. Located at Manor Court Community Centre, West End Avenue, Royston, S71 4LN.
The Community Fridge at the Cabin	Open to all. Saving food from landfill, donated by local supermarkets and food retailers. Please follow and check Facebook (The Community Fridge at the Cabin) for up to date information on opening days and times. Located at 18c King Street, Hoyland, S74 9JP.
Community Fridge Barnsley	1 bag per household. A bag of food is free but there may be a small charge for certain food items. Please follow and check Facebook (Community Fridge Barnsley) for up to date information on opening days and times. Located at Mapplewell Village Hall, Darton Lane, Mapplewell, S75 6AL.
Community Shop	Community Shop membership is free and open to those who live locally to a Community Shop store and receive a means-tested benefit. If you think you may be eligible, find your nearest Community Shop and contact them directly about membership.

Storehouse & Field	Membership model – £3.50 per week or £30 per month. Standard - £7.50 per week or £60 per month Family Basket - £15 per week. £5 membership for the year = member benefits.
