



Motability

What is Motability?

The Motability Scheme provides a cost-effective option for people with disabilities to lease a car, scooter, or wheelchair.

Who Qualifies?

If you require an adapted vehicle, powered wheelchair or scooter but need help with the cost, you may be able to join the Motability Scheme. You must receive one of the following to be eligible:

- The enhanced rate Mobility component of Personal Independence Payment (PIP)
- The higher rate Mobility component of Disability Living Allowance (DLA)
- The War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement (WPMS)
- The Armed Forces Independence Payment (AFIP)
- The higher rate Mobility component of the Child Disability Payment (CDP)

You must receive one of the benefits listed above before applying to join the scheme. If you care for a disabled person you can apply to join the scheme, as long as the car is used on behalf of the disabled person.

Your mobility allowance will cover the cost of leasing the vehicle and will be paid directly to Mobility Operations Ltd. If you require a more expensive car, or adaptations, you'll need to make an extra payment called an Advance Payment. Motability offers grants to support you with this payment. How to Apply

If you would like to join the scheme you need to:

1. Find one out of 4,500 Motability dealers
2. Choose an appropriate vehicle
3. Order the vehicle
