

TV Licence Concessions (i)

Depending on your age or health condition, you may be eligible for a discounted or free TV licence.

About

Who Qualifies?

To be eligible for a discounted or free TV licence, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be over 75 and receiving Pension Credit
- 2. Live in a residential care home, supported housing or sheltered accommodation
- 3. Have a severe visual impairment or live with someone who is blind or severely sight impaired (you are not eligible if you are partially sighted)

How To Apply

- 1. If you're over 75 and receiving Pension Credit you can apply for a free TV licence. You can apply online or by phone:

- By phone: 0300 790 6117 (8.30am 6.30pm, Monday to Friday)
- If you live in a care home or supported housing, you do not need to apply for a concession. The Manager of the home is responsible for applying for an accommodation for residential care (ARC) concessionary TV Licence.
- 3. If you are blind or live with someone who has a severe sight impairment, you can apply for a 50% concessionary TV licence. You will need to provide proof of your sight impairment, such as a certificate from your local council or ophthalmologist which states that you're registered blind or severely sight impaired. You can apply online for your concessionary TV licence.
