



Wheelchair Services

Sheffield Wheelchair Services offers access to a wheelchair and accessories for people who live in Barnsley, as well as Sheffield.

Who Qualifies?

To access the service, you must meet the following criteria:

- Have limited walking ability
- Have a long-term health condition which is likely to last longer than 6 months
- Be terminally ill

How To Apply

To access the service you must be referred by a GP, therapist or community nurse. Once the relevant health professional has made the referral on your behalf, Sheffield Wheelchair Services will decide whether you are eligible for a wheelchair. They may decide they need more information before allocating a wheelchair. In this case, you may need an assessment, either via a home visit or an appointment at the Mobility and Specialised Rehabilitation Centre, Northern General Hospital.
